



ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES - APM PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS COMMITTEE

Role	Responsibility
Committee Chair	Chair PSC meetings, responsible for ensuring PSC complies with terms of reference, responsible for agreeing work programme and reporting back to the executive committee
Elected Member (x4) (TP, VV, MC, FB)	Elected committee member responsible for supporting and developing work of the PSC as outlined in the TOR
Representatives (elected)	
APM Representative to RCP Revalidation Network (FB)	Responsible for answering specialist specific queries about medical appraisal and revalidation passed on from the RCP. Responsible for attending relevant RCP speciality appraisal and revalidation events and feeding back to the committee. Responsible for exploring and understanding members issues around this topic and bringing to the committee for action
SSAS Representative (ES)	To represent the SSAS doctors on the PSC and actively participate and engage in the work projects lead by both committees. To maintain the two way communication between the PSC and SSAS committees.
Trainee Representative (AP)	The role of the trainee representative is to represent trainee perspectives to the PSC, to participate in the work of the PSC, to feedback to the Trainees committee (and from there to all trainees) what is being done by the PSC and to participate in the work of the Trainees committee.
Junior Representative	Encourage two-way communication between the PSC and Juniors committee of the APM. To represent the Juniors perspective on the PSC and the work of the PSC to the Juniors committee.

Audit Working Group Representative (AD)	Role involves leading on national audits and audit pilots for APM.
