About the Role – Research and Ethics Representative

This role is aimed at maintaining and strengthening communication between the Trainees' Committee and trainees nationally, via a network of regional APM trainee representatives.

Specific tasks:

Link between the Trainee's Committee and Research and Ethics Committee

- Attend Research & Ethics (R&E) committee meetings. These are generally online and held four times per year.
- Represent the views of trainees on the R&E committee and report back to the trainee body if needed.
- Actively contribute to the work on the R&E committee as required. This may include reviewing or writing documents or contributing to other projects that may arise.
- Contribute to the APM/ PCRS Research Course +/- the APM Ethics Course if needed and if able.

Link between APM Academic Trainees Special Interest Forum (SIF)

- Support the SIF as appropriate, and provide a link between the trainees committee and the SIF.
- Being an academic trainee/ research active is not a requirement for this role and the SIF work is optional.

Contributing to the wider work of the APM Trainees committee including:

- Attend trainees committee meetings (5-6 meetings per year)
- Preparation of communications report for trainees committee meetings, with updates on activities conducted/feedback from the regional representatives.
- Support the communications coordinator to take the minutes at the APM trainee committee meeting in their absence and distribute these within the week.
- Contribute to ensuring regular, timely announcements within the WhatsApp community group.
- Flag up interesting or relevant research to the committees and be aware of emerging ethical issues.
